

## Leaving a gift in your Will

Leaving Welfare Rights Centre a gift in your Will can make a real difference, providing a lasting legacy of your values and wishes.

There are a number of ways you can leave a gift in your Will. Below we have provided some suggested wording but we recommend that if you're making or updating a Will, you speak with a solicitor to ensure your Will is valid and intentions clearly stated. We also suggest speaking with family to ensure your wishes are known.

- **A general bequest leaving a specific sum**

"I give, devise and bequeath to the Welfare Rights Centre (ABN 76002708714) of 102/55 Holt Street, Sydney, New South Wales, Australia, or its successor, free from all duties and taxes, the sum of \$(amount) to be used for its general purposes. The receipt of any authorised officer of this organisation is sufficient discharge to my executors in respect of that gift."

- **A percentage bequest**

"I give, devise and bequeath to the Welfare Rights Centre (ABN 76002708714) of 102/55 Holt Street, Sydney, New South Wales, Australia, or its successor, free from all duties and taxes, (the desired percentage)% of my estate to be used for its general purposes. The receipt of any authorised officer of this organisation is sufficient discharge to my executors in respect of that gift."

- **A residuary bequest, which donates everything remaining in your estate after bequests to family and heirs**

"I give, devise and bequeath to the Welfare Rights Centre (ABN 76002708714) of 102/55 Holt Street, Sydney, New South Wales, Australia, or its successor, free from all duties and taxes, the residue of my estate to be used for its general purposes. The receipt of any authorised officer of this organisation is sufficient discharge to my executors in respect of that gift."
